



COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTIONS FUND

Linden Hills Co-op is pleased to be able to offer modest donations to a variety of community nonprofit organizations through our Community Contributions Fund. Most of our support is provided in the form of co-op donation **vouchers**, generally in amounts not to exceed \$50, which can be used to purchase goods from the co-op, or as **gift cards**, which may be used as door prizes or silent auction items. Gift cards are redeemable at Linden Hills Co-op. Occasionally, we are also able to donate store merchandise.

Our budget is limited, so we advise you to **apply a minimum of six weeks in advance** of your event or the date by which you need the donation, whichever is earlier.

In order to qualify for a cash or in-kind charitable contribution, organizations must:

1. Be nonprofit (that is, a public library, public school, or charitable organization as described in IRS Section 501(c)(3)) and nonpartisan (that is, not affiliated with or promoting any specific political party or candidate);
2. Be non-discriminatory on the basis of any legally recognized category including but not limited to race, creed, gender, national origin, age, sexual orientation, or physical disability;
3. Not be using the contribution to advance a particular religious belief (religiously affiliated schools are not disqualified so long as they are located in Linden Hills and surrounding neighborhoods and the contribution supports the school in general and not the church/synagogue/mosque or religion in particular; and
4. Use the contribution for specific projects or events rather than promotions or operations.

Priority is given to neighborhood organizations and events that are aligned with Linden Hills Co-op's Ends Policies, which are:

- **Provides and promotes healthful food choices;**
- **Uses and promotes earth-friendly, sustainable products;**
- **Encourages activism on sustainability, health and nutrition-related issues; and**
- **Builds community within Linden Hills and surrounding neighborhoods.**
